A. REQUIRED UNIFORM

Uniforming is one of the tenants of Boy Scouting. Because this course is designed to build and foster leadership, **complete and Official B.S.A uniforming** of the participants **WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED**. No other clothing is permitted at any time.

REMEMBER, SEVEN DAYS WORTH OF OFFICIAL B.S.A. CLOTHING ARE NECESSARY. This does not mean you need (7) B.S.A. shirts/pants/sock sets. You need to be in uniform for 7 days. Pack detergent for sink washing of clothes.
